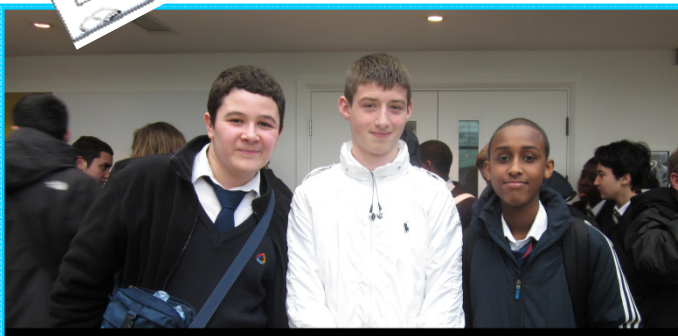
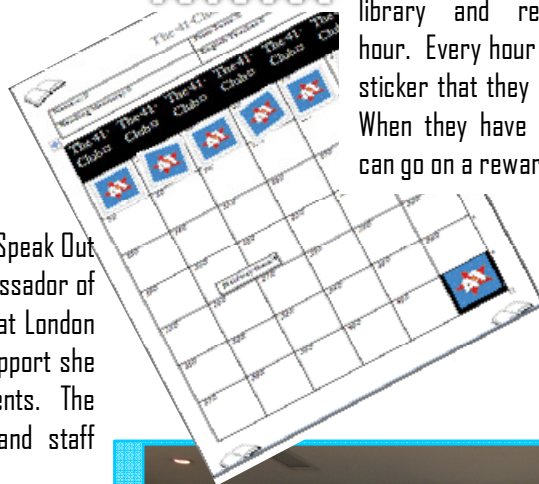
**“Speak out Challenge”**

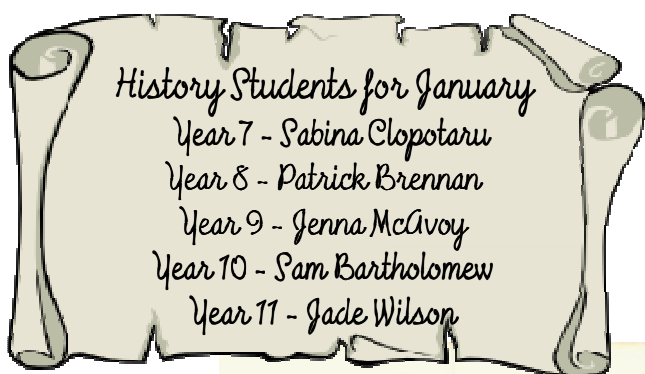
**The 41 Club**

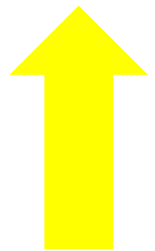
