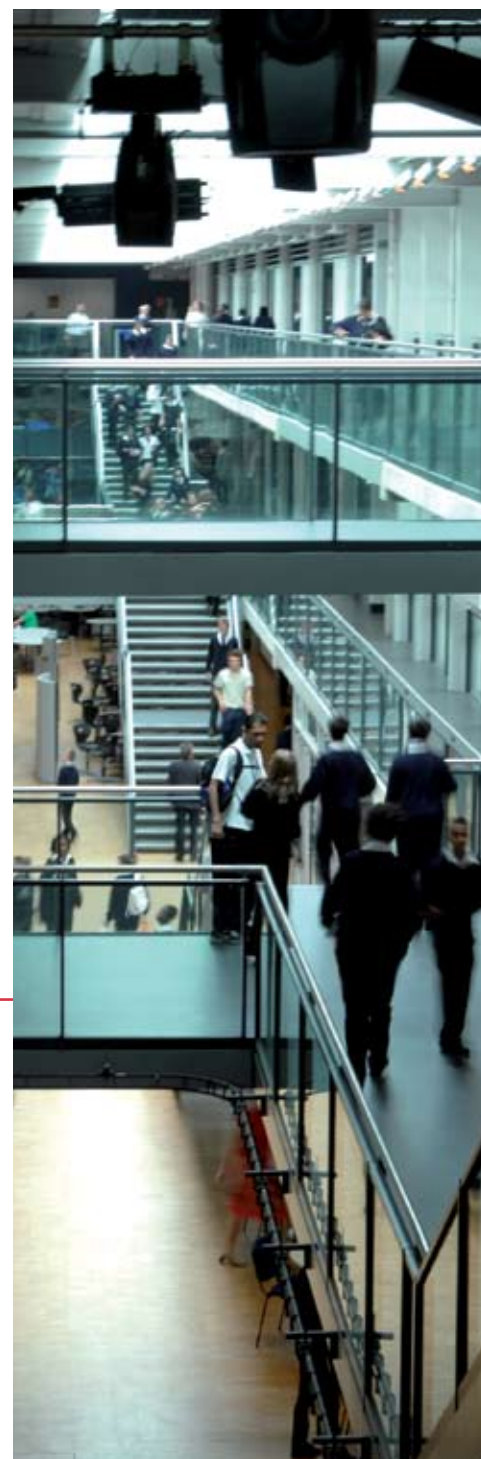
21st Century resources and facilities

London Academy Sixth Form welcomes all students

We now have 23 Advanced Level subjects and 7 different occupational courses offered at level 3 (Advanced level) and level 2 (GCSE level).

Students can study a package of qualifications including:

- Advanced Level (AS and A2 Levels)
- BTEC courses in Business, Art, Health & Social Care, Leisure & Tourism
- Occupational courses in Construction, Engineering & Hairdressing
- GCSE
- Life Skills qualifications
- Sports Leadership qualifications

The majority of students progress to university

Over 80% of our students progress to university, including the London School of Economics, Imperial, Manchester, Edinburgh, Queen Mary's London, Warwick, Bristol and Reading.

A variety of degrees are studied including Medicine, Forensic Science, Dentistry, Law, Maths, Engineering, Media Studies, Art & Design and Computing.

Students at London Academy Sixth Form have excelled both locally and nationally in Art, Drama, Sport and Science.

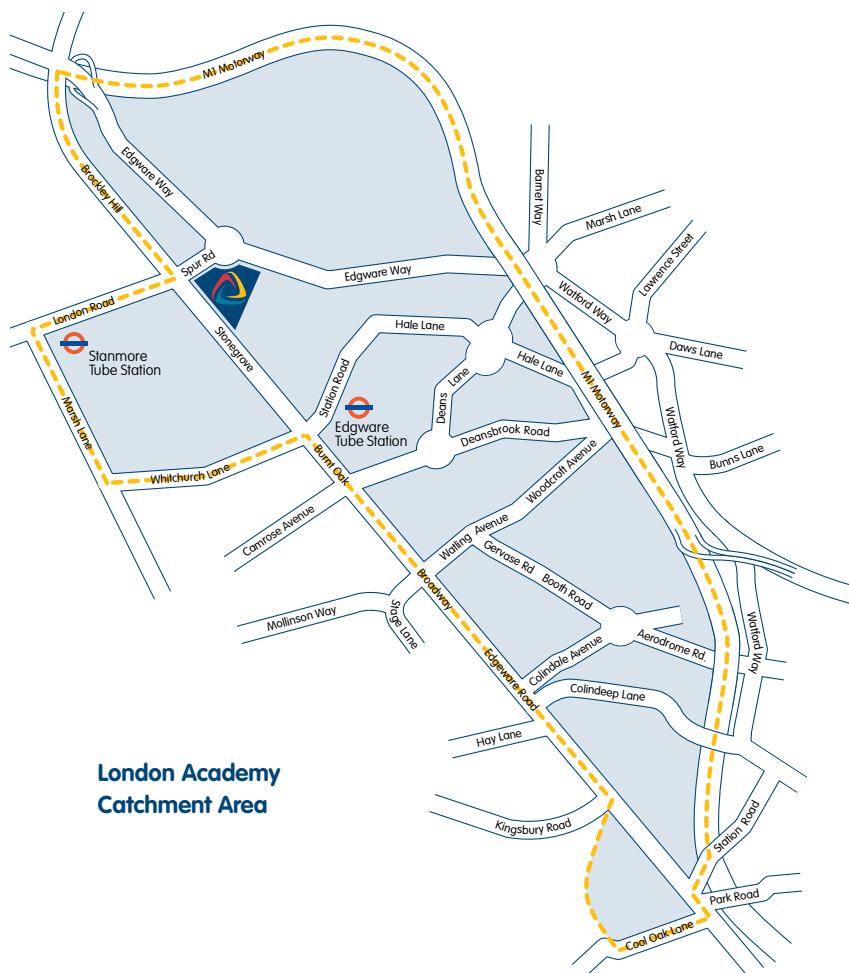


What happens next?

By Bus

Bus 107 alight at Spur Road. Bus 142 alight at St. Peter's Church, Stonegrove. Buses 113 and 288 alight at Edgwarebury Lane near junction with Edgware Way. Buses 32, 79, 186, 204, 221, 240, 251, 292, 305, 340, alight at Edgware Station.

By London Underground

Jubilee Line to Stanmore Tube Station (10 minutes to London Academy), Northern Line to Edgware Station (12 minutes to London Academy).

By Car or Cycle

London Academy is situated on Spur Road. Drivers are asked not to park on roads near the Academy. In the interests of safety, students should be set down in Green Lane. Drivers cannot bring cars on to the academy site to pick up students. We have ample facilities for the storage of bicycles.
