



London Academy – Uniform Policy

1.0 Introduction

1.1 Students must be in uniform at all times. All staff are responsible for ensuring this is the case.

Girls' Uniform

- **London Academy** Navy blue blazer
- **London Academy** Navy blue jumper, **London Academy** clip-on tie and Plain white shirt
- Plain black trousers or skirts in a conventional fit, fabric and style (no denim, jeans, corduroy or leggings)
- White socks or black/natural tights
- Sensible plain black shoes (no trainers or boots)
- Hair bands must be navy blue, black or white Hijabs must be plain navy blue, black or white
- Plain navy blue or black outdoor coat (no hooded sweatshirt style jackets)

Girls' PE Kit

- **London Academy** Blue Sweatshirt, **London Academy** White sports shirt, **London Academy** Blue games shorts
- White sports socks Trainers
- Football boots and shin pads (optional)
- Swimming costume, Towel

Boys' Uniform

- **London Academy** Navy blue blazer
- **London Academy** Navy blue jumper, **London Academy** clip-on tie and Plain white shirt
- Plain black trousers in a conventional fit, fabric and style (no denim, jeans or corduroy)
- Sensible plain black shoes (no trainers or boots)
- Plain navy blue or black outdoor coat (no hooded sweatshirt style jackets)

Boys' PE Kit

- **London Academy** Blue Sweatshirt, **London Academy** White sports shirt, **London Academy** Blue games shorts
- White sports socks Trainers
- Football boots and shin pads (optional)
- Swimming costume, Towel

During the summer term, uniform requirements are adjusted, and the navy-blue school jumper is not permitted.

Primary School uniform expectations

- Plain, formal, black leather/leather looking shoes (sports trainers, plimsolls, boots etc. not to be worn unless medical evidence can be provided otherwise)
- Plain black or white socks
- Black tights if choose to wear
- Plain black trousers or skirts of conventional fit (no denim, corduroy, or leggings)
- Plain white polo top (Reception students only)
- Plain white, buttoned collared shirt (Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6)
- London Academy tie (Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6)



- London Academy V-neck jumper
- Hair bands must be plain navy blue, black or white and Hijabs must be plain navy blue, black or white.
- Plain navy blue or black outdoor coat (no hooded sweatshirt style sports branded jackets) without any logo/stripes etc

Primary School PE Kit

- Plain, white or black sports trainers
- London Academy shorts
- Plain navy blue or black jogging bottoms, if choose to wear instead of shorts
- London Academy polo top or plain white t-shirt
- London Academy sweatshirt/sports jumper, if choose to wear
- Black or white socks

All uniform items are available to purchase from Academy including any second hand uniform that the we have available.

2.1 Uniform can be ordered via WisePay or ordered at break & lunch time from reception and Collected after school.

The school will also sell replacement Student Diaries if your son/daughter should lose theirs.

- Items of jewellery other than wristwatches, ear-studs, will be confiscated.
- Any such items being confiscated must be placed in a sealed envelope and given to one of the Deputy Principals for safe-keeping in the strong-room or safe.
- Students who have a genuine reason for not being able to wear the correct or complete uniform should bring a letter of explanation from home so the Heads of Student Learning can issue temporary written permission for that student to wear other items of clothing. In the case of genuine hardship the problem is referred to the Head of Student Learning and Deputy Principal for resolution.
- Students who are unsure about the suitability of clothing they or their parents intend purchasing, should be advised to consult the school **before** purchase.

3.0 Responsibilities

- It is the responsibility of students to wear correct uniform at all times.
- Families must ensure students are in correct uniform when they leave home.
- Form Tutors must ensure students are in correct uniform when they enter and leave registration.
- It is the responsibility of **all** staff to ensure that correct student uniform is always worn. This is particularly the case when students are representing the Academy.
